4th - 8th Student Writing Intensive Level B Introduction: Using an incremental approach, this program teaches not just what to write, but how to write by providing the student with practical writing tools, Recorded live with Mr. Andrew Pudewa, this four-DVD writing course for middle school students new to IEW lays a solid foundation of writing skills.
