

## ***JUBILEE Participation Agreement for Students***

As followers of Christ we are called to live blameless lives before God and each other. Above and beyond any details or lists, let us not put a stumbling block before our brothers and sisters, but honor God in our conduct, speech and dress. Let us rise to standards that are higher rather than lower; Godly rather than worldly; wholesome rather than questionable. Any list that tries to thoroughly describe every detail and nuance of conduct/dress will always be incomplete. Therefore, the following outline of specific guidelines should be read with the above broad principles in mind.

***JUBILEE parent members agree to sign this agreement, which outlines the behavior and dress code, as part of the application process. Youth age twelve and up will individually sign this form, as we recognize their ability to be responsible in part on these issues.***

In CONDUCT, students are expected to...

- Obey all rules and instructions given by the teacher/guide leading the event. (The Lord has appointed authorities over us, according to Colossians 3:20, Romans 13:1.)
- Show consideration by controlling noise level and activity in areas shared with others.
- Be considerate of those younger than you.
- Not push, hit, kick, or roughhouse.
- Not participate in public displays of affection, i.e., hand-holding, kissing, etc. In every relationship, be a godly example beyond reproach.
- Use appropriate discretion with any electronic devices.
- Keep the facilities and grounds neat.
- Stay with the group on field trips. At the church, stay in permitted areas.

In SPEECH, students are expected to...

- Listen when someone else is talking.
- Speak respectfully to each other. Inappropriate language, including name calling will not be tolerated.

In DRESS, students are expected to...

- Dress modestly at all times so as to not be a distraction to others.
- Wear appropriate, not revealing underclothing (both male and female students). Clothing must adequately cover all midriff skin, cleavage, & thighs. Tops & bottoms must overlap even when arms are raised. Necklines should not be revealing. Spaghetti strapped shirts are to be covered with an over-shirt. Skirts and shorts must be modest.
- Be considerate of slogans on t-shirts. Choose something else to wear if you question its appropriateness.
- When a student's clothing does not align with the guidelines, a coordinator or parent has the right to request a change or covering of the clothing by the student. If a change or covering is not possible, the student will be asked to leave the event.

***As a family, we have discussed the behavior and dress code listed above and agree to follow them. We support the goal of JUBILEE to create an atmosphere where Christian relationships and fun coexist with respect for others.***
