

Statement of Faith

- We believe the Bible to be the inspired, inerrant, and infallible Word of God, and of supreme and final authority in faith and life.
- We believe that there is one living and true God; an infinite, intelligent Spirit, perfect in all His attributes, one in essence but eternal subsistent in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
- We believe in the fall of man; although originally created in the image of God, through the disobedience of Adam, man fell into a sinful and spiritually impotent state, totally unable to justify himself before God.
- We believe that Jesus Christ is the express image of the invisible God, which is to say He is God; that He became man, yet without sin, being conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary; that He died on the cross as a substitutionary sacrifice for sin; that He arose from the dead in the body in which He was crucified; that He ascended into heaven in that body glorified, where He is now, our interceding High Priest; and that He will return again personally, visibly, and gloriously.
- We believe that salvation is wholly of God, by grace; that God in love gave His only Son to die on the cross for sin, thus procuring the redemption of those who come to Him; that this salvation is not merited in any way by man; that God commands men everywhere to repent of sin and believe in Christ, and that this salvation through Christ results in good works.

Our Dress Code

Applies to All HEAD Functions; Applies to Adults and Children

Members should be aware of the reflection they are placing on HEAD by the way they dress.

- There will be no low cut necklines, bare midriffs, tank tops (shoulder straps less than three inches wide), halter tops, tight fitting shirts, or bare backs. Sheer clothing constitutes as no clothing, and is not acceptable.
- Bottom edge/hem of shorts, skirts and dresses should be lower than fingertips when hands are at sides.
- For swimming events: girls will wear modest one-piece swimsuits with shorts; boys will wear modest swim trunks with a t-shirt.

Our Conduct Guidelines

While participating in HEAD meetings, field trips, activities or events, we represent the Lord Jesus Christ, HEAD, and the public perception of home schoolers in general. We will be judged by our actions and attitudes, behavior, and dress. To be proper representatives, the following guidelines will be followed while participating in HEAD meetings, field trips, activities or events:

- Member families will act in such a way that their words and actions promote the unity and encouragement of other HEAD families.
- Member families will avoid acting in such a way that is considered disrespectful, offensive, immoral, intimidating, rude, or in any way which may bring reproach on the corporation or home education.
- Adults and children will abide by the HEAD dress code.
- There is to be no dating or dating behavior at HEAD activities and field trips.
- Member families will be responsible for their own children's behavior to ensure they are acting in accordance with these conduct guidelines.
- Any members or leaders of HEAD who persist in violating these conduct guidelines are considered to be conducting themselves in a way that is contrary to the specific and primary purpose of HEAD. Section 5 of Article IX of the By-laws of HEAD allows that such members may have their membership revoked by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors.
