Hearts-at-Home Team Descriptions

Adventure Club (for ages 4-10; age 3 with direct parental supervision; meets 4 times a year) - Adventure into books, art, science, history, geography and much more! Club time introduces a theme, includes a variety of enrichment activities and focuses on student presentations of reports. This team will plan, organize, and implement the “Adventure Club” meetings.

Adventure Club Team Member Tasks (for two of the four events per year):

- Assist with the planning of themes and activities
- Teachers (needed for each age group)
- Setup and cleanup
- Plan and prepare crafts

Field Trips - This team will plan and implement monthly field trips that are educational in nature and appeal to a wide range of ages.

Field Trips Team Member Tasks:

- Help plan and coordinate field trips
- Check in participants
- Basic computer skills required to forward list of participants to treasurer

11 & Up (participants must turn 11 by December 31st of current school season)
– This team will plan one social event and/or one field trip (educational in nature) per month for this age group. (Note: some events may be “drop-off” activities.)
