History

The Home School Physical Education Program will begin its twenty-third year. The program began with twenty students in 1987 and had over two hundred in 2008-09. Although the program has grown significantly over the years, the goal of the program continues to be integrating Christian values in the discipline of physical education, and hopefully, re-enforcing principles students are being taught at home, through a fun and challenging environment.

The Classes

The typical Home School physical education class will begin with prayer., followed by calisthenics, coordination skills or jogging, skill development (teaching session), and games which often incorporate the skill being taught. The specific material a student will learn is based on their age and skill level, seeking to introduce new skills, or improving on skills already acquired. **The Fall schedule will begin the week of September 8th and the last classes of the semester will be the week of December 15th. No classes will be held the week of Thanksgiving.**
