Enrichment Day Expectations:

“Enrichment Day” is a cooperative effort on the part of C.A.C.H.E. homeschooling families who desire to work with other homeschooling families in the Body of Christ to enrich our children’s education. Classes will be coordinated, supervised and led by homeschool parents. Programs will operate on a co-op basis, so every adult is expected to be an active participant on one team (see options below) - sharing input, ideas, planning and presenting material, and assisting however needed. When children are present, a parent from that family must also be present in the building (unless prior arrangements have been made with the Support Team.)

Enrichment Day Goals:

1. To glorify God as we represent both Christ and homechooling in a positive light to the community.
2. To exhibit and grow in Christ-like behavior in our attitudes, actions and words as we interact with others.
3. To experience fun and fellowship as friendships are developed with like-minded peers while we learn and work together.
4. To provide supplemental learning opportunities to enrich our children’s education in the areas of physical education, the arts, life skills, and other electives.

CLASSES

Preschool (ages 0-5)

Stories, snacks, crafts, and play time too!

Elementary (ages 5-12)

- **Gym:** Students will participate in a variety of sports activities and games – basketball, dodgeball, four-square, etc.
- **The Incredible Race (Answers in Genesis):** Get ready to run The Incredible Race! One Family, One Race, One Savior! Kids will race from continent to continent uncovering clues and attempting challenges as they fill their score cards. They’ll also discover that, no matter where we live, what shade of skin we have, or what language we speak, we are all part of the same race—the human race—and all part of the same family from Adam and Eve.

Teens (ages 13 & up)

- **Study Hall:** A relaxed, yet adult supervised, atmosphere for teens to read a book or work on homework. There is an air hockey and ping pong table to play and board games. On nice days we may choose to walk down to the local coffee shop.
