

Easley Home Educators Graduation Ceremony

- Easley Home Educators hosts a graduation ceremony each year. Since our goal is to have a senior class that knows each other well, we require students and their families to be active EHE members in both their junior and senior years. Being an active member requires being involved in at least one area of EHE, with at least 70% participation in that one area. Areas that qualify are clubs and co-op (not one-time activities).
- One parent and the student are required to attend and serve at graduation in the student's junior year. This serves two purposes: It allows them to see what they will experience a year later, and it allows the senior families to enjoy the night, while the junior families take care of jobs such as serving refreshments and facility cleanup. This is a non-negotiable requirement, so plan to be available the night of graduation of your student's junior year.
- Graduation Fees are nonrefundable once paid. Please be sure of your participation before paying fees.
- Only EHE-distributed cords and stoles are permitted to be worn at the EHE Graduation.
- EHE does not distribute diplomas or transcripts, as we are a support group, not a legal umbrella group. During the ceremony, we provide paper scrolls for the parent to hand to their student. If you desire to order a diploma for your student, it can be displayed at the student's reception area.
- The graduation fee is \$150 and covers the following graduation expenses:
 - EHE yearbook
 - Cap, Gown and Tassel
 - Facility Fee
 - Guest Speaker
 - Accompanist
 - Food and Decorations for Reception
 - Graduation Programs
 - Printing of Last Will and Testament
 - Photography if budget allows
