Homeschool co-ops, like clouds, take many shapes and forms, each group changing to meet the needs of its members. They come in more flavors than Baskin Robbins' ice cream. One size doesn't fit all, either. While some groups seem to work more harmoniously than other groups, there is no single group that makes 100% of its members happy, 100% of the time. Nor do 100% of the members take 100% advantage of all the wonderful opportunities available to them through their group. Firmly Planted is unique in that we come at homeschooling and all of its wonderful and challenging facets from a decidedly Christian perspective. Our commitment to assist parents in their homeschooling journey is boosted by the support of the local church.

We are not a "support group" in the traditional sense of the word, either. Our co-op functions because each person in it assumes the responsibility of partnering with us in many different ways. Firmly Planted was God's idea!

Firmly Planted was founded in 2013 as an answer to prayer. The desire was to have a group of families who could get together for support and encouragement ~ and just maybe we could offer classes to students as a way to form friendships and enrich our homeschooling curriculum. God's hand has blessed Firmly Planted, and we have seen it grow in leaps and bounds in a relatively short period of time. Over the years, we have been blessed by the talents of many committed parents who have stepped forward to offer themselves as servants in an effort to see this ministry succeed.

We began with 12 families and a handful of classes in the fall of 2013, this school year we have 49 families with over 100 students in 3 dozen classes. Our students range from nursery/preschool through high school.

What is the Cost?

Membership dues for Firmly Planted are \$120 per year per family, renewable each June. There is a \$35 background check fee upon initial enrollment. When a family enrolls half way through the year, the dues are prorated to \$60 and a \$35 background check fee (The full cost for classes is charged). This covers building costs, insurance, mailings, postage, website, legal fees, and other costs.

What is the Benefit?

Your Firmly Planted membership fee allows your family to participate in all Firmly Planted activities. Membership is open to all homeschooling families.

Communication

Email is our primary form of communication — announcements are sent out on a regular basis to advise of upcoming events and changes to previous plans. We also utilize our membership only webpage, where friendships are built and member-initiated gatherings and field trips are announced.

We believe:

- The Bible is the inspired, infallible, literal, and authoritative Word of God.
