Terms of Participation in GCCHS Graduation

We strive to make sure the experience is a positive one for all of the participating families and students. Graduates or family members with any complaints should address them privately with a GCCHS graduation volunteer. GCCHS reserves the right to deny participation immediately or during a GCCHS graduation and/or related activity, including forfeiture of all fees without a refund for failing to adhere to the conditions enumerated above.

Graduation Day

PARENTS: You will be walking on stage to meet your senior to present his/her diploma. Therefore, seats are reserved for parents of graduating seniors **ONLY**. If you have other children, grandparents, friends and relatives coming to the graduation you will need to have them sit **behind** the reserved parent seating. They may want to come early to get a good seat.

Parents will be ushered in right before the graduates.

Graduation will start promptly at 10:00AM

- **Rehearsal**
 - **Every graduate must attend rehearsal.**
 - This will be the **only** chance you will have to walk through the ceremony with the other graduates, so it is very important that you attend. The graduates will proceed in and out of the auditorium, so it is important for each graduate to know who they follow, where to sit, when to cross the stage etc.
- **Display Tables**
 - A display table for your graduate to showcase his/her accomplishments will be available, but it will be **OPTIONAL**. GCCHS will need to know by **March 1, 2020** if your graduate will be having a display table. Please send email notification to [**gcchswebsite@gmail.com**](mailto:gcchswebsite@gmail.com)
 - The graduate will have a 60- inch round table for display.
 - No adhesives are allowed on any surface of the room we are using.
 - Each family will provide their own table covering. You are free to use any colors or designs that you choose.
 - No glitter is allowed on your tables.
 - Please do not bring electronics that require a plug.
 - We recommend that nothing be displayed that is heavy or cumbersome as the distance from the parking lot to the church is a bit of a walk. Keep it simple.

- GCCHS highly suggests that you NOT bring anything of value. The church and GCCHS will not be responsible for anything that goes missing
- We suggest that you not have a basket or bag to receive cards at the display table. Have your guests give you the gift or card personally.
- All displayed items must conform to GCCHS standards. The Steering Committee reserves the right to ask any offensive items to be removed.
- You are responsible for taking down the display before leaving the reception.
- **The Ceremony**
 - The graduation ceremony will begin at **10:00am** with a processional of the graduates.
 - The length of the ceremony will depend upon the number of graduates, but the goal is **no more than 1 1/2 hours**.
- **Invocation and Benediction:**
 - Will be given by the Master of Ceremonies and commencement speaker.
- **Awarding of Diplomas:**
 - As each graduate crosses the stage to receive his/her diploma, the GCCHS Master of Ceremonies will either read the biographical information provided about the graduate.
 - Attached to this packet is a **Biographical Information Sheet** that needs to be **completed and returned by March 1, 2020**.
- **Power Point Presentation/Photos of Graduates:**
 - In addition to the biographical information, a PowerPoint presentation with photos of the graduate that are shown during the ceremony on a screen located behind the graduate and on the opposite wall for the graduate and parents to see.
 - The photos that are in PowerPoint Presentation should be:
 - Photos of the graduate during elementary years, pre-teen or early teen years, and some recent, such as a graduate portrait
 - The photos can be color or black and white
 - Please send 10 pictures
 - Please submit the song you would like to play on video and if you prefer a particular starting point make sure to send the start time.
 - Please submit pictures, clip of music which you would like played must be sent by **March 1, 2020** to [**gcchswebsite@gmail.com**](mailto:gcchswebsite@gmail.com)

- Because GCCHS is out sourcing the compilation of the photos used during the ceremony, any photo submitted after that date will not be guaranteed inclusion.
- **It is important to make arrangements for your child's senior portraits to be made in time to submit them to GCCHS before the deadline of March 1, 2020.**
- **Honor Graduate Recognitions:**
 - We would like to recognize those home school graduates who have excelled academically and are named honor graduates.
 - To qualify as an honor graduate, you must fulfill at least one of the following criteria:
 - Member of Eta Sigma Alpha or another official honor society
 - Earned at least a 3.5 GPA
 - Completed a minimum of 3 honors level high school classes
 - Please send a transcript to GCCHS.
 - If you qualify as an honor graduate, you will be allowed to wear gold cords with your cap and gown. They can be purchased for an extra fee.
- **Special Awards for GCCHS Members ONLY:**
 - GCCHS will present special awards to deserving graduates. We want to recognize those outstanding seniors who have excelled academically or who have given of their time and talent in serving others.
 - **Community Service Award:** Attached to this packet is a Community Service Award application. If your graduate wants to be considered for this award, he/she should complete the application and submit it to GCCHS no later than **April 1, 2020**.
 - **GCCHS Service & Leadership Award:** Attached to this packet is a Christian Leadership Award application. If your graduate wants to be considered for this award, he/she should complete the application and submit it to GCCHS no later than **April 1, 2020**.
 - **Valedictorian/Salutatorian:** Attached to this packet is a Valedictorian/Salutatorian application. If your graduate wants to be considered for this award, he/she should complete the application and submit it to GCCHS no later than **April 1, 2020**.

Who Qualifies? This award seeks to reward students who have made community service a priority. The applicant must have been home educated for at least three years, with the senior year counting as one year. The applicant's family must have been a member of GCCHS for a minimum of three years total. The applicant must also be a participant in the GCCHS graduation ceremony.

Who will be awarded?

Because this honor focuses more on life goals than on academic accomplishments, the primary assignment is to write an essay as described below. Decisions will be made based on the number of hours and depth of work the volunteer has done. The recipient selected for the year's award will be announced and awarded at the GCCHS graduation ceremony.

To apply for the award, include the following information in your email/essay:

- Graduate's Full Name
- Number of years home schooled
- An essay answering the question: Why do you volunteer?
- List all of the volunteer service activities (including service in your church) with the specific # of hours and a description of the services.
- A letter of verification from the supervisor who managed your volunteer hours.
- Include the dates of service and the average number of hours spent per week
- If it was a one-time project/activity, include the total number of hours spent and designate as a one-time project.
