

Group and Field Trip Guidelines

- When you are out and about at a GCCHS group function, you are representing GCCHS. Please be sure it is a positive reflection on the group.
- Parents are always responsible for the behavior of their children.
- All field trips and events are required to follow the GCCHS field trip guidelines.
- GCCHS Events are only open to current GCCHS members household and grandparents, unless otherwise specified.
 - If your field trip includes grandparents, they must have a signed waiver on file with GCCHS or bring one to the event.
- Members must call their event coordinator with any problems or questions, DO NOT call the facility or venue yourself. All questions about the facility, concerns, and reservations must be directed to GCCHS, not to the venue itself
- Signups/payment must be completed/postmarked by the deadline set by the Field trip Coordinator.
- No drop offs or meet ups. Please do not ask to go to your coordinators home to drop off payment at the last moment.
- If your payment is not received by the due date, your sign up will be removed from the calendar (probably without notice).
- Free field trips/events require a deposit check to hold your space; your deposit will be returned to you when you arrive at the field trip/event.
- Field trips and events do not offer refunds for cancellations or no shows.
- If you have a ticket to an event that you now cannot attend, please contact your event coordinator to ensure that you can sell your tickets on the forum and notify them of whomever you sell to.
- If you have an unexpected circumstance and cannot attend an event you're signed up for, please be sure to contact your coordinator in the way they have instructed on the sign up.
- Members are expected to show up for field trips at the required time.
- At an event with multiple sign up options, members are expected to only attend those portions of a field trip they have paid for.
- Members and their families are expected to follow good etiquette while on field trips. When on a field trip we want to leave a good impression of homeschoolers with the facility when we leave.
 - Follow all the rules of the facility
 - Be respectful of any guides, teachers or docents who are talking.
 - Children are expected to stay with the group, or their chaperone at all times
 - Be polite and thoughtful in behavior and actions
 - Dress modestly and behave in a G-rated manner.

We love our volunteers, and we want them to keep volunteering and providing us with fun, exciting events for our families. This is why we ask for everyone to follow the field trip guidelines. Failure to follow these guidelines can result in suspension of field trip and event privileges or may result in removal from the group.
