These guidelines are not meant to burden, but rather to set boundaries that will allow all to enjoy the freedom we have in Christ.

Code of Conduct

- 1. Public displays of affection are not permitted. This includes kissing, caressing, extended embracing, sitting on laps of opposites sex, etc.
- 2. Due to COVID restrictions, there will be no slow dancing allowed. Dance etiquette is expected. This means no provocative movements of any kind. Appropriate distance between dance partners is required. (Let's leave room for Jesus.)
- 3. All students must remain within the marked perimeters of the premises until the conclusion of the dance. Students should not leave the dance early unless their parents have given PRIOR permission. Once a student leaves the dance, they will not be allowed back in.
- 4. No alcohol, drugs, or weapons of any kind will be permitted.

Dress Code

All Students:

- Undergarments must be covered
- Tennis shoes and shower shoes may not be worn

Young Men:

- Collared, button up shirt is required
- Necktie or bow tie are required
- Tuxedo, suits, or slacks and sports coat are required
- No jeans, tennis shoes, or sandals

Young Ladies:

- Attire is required and expected to be modest. Please consider Christ when selecting a dress.
- Floor length, cocktail or tea length dresses are acceptable. Short dresses **must** sit at the top of the knee.
- No Slits above the knee. No Pant Suits.
- Neckline must cover the chest so that no cleavage is showing.
- Strapless gowns are acceptable. (Remember, you will be moving around. Make sure your dress will stay in place.)
- Backs of dresses may be no lower than the bottom of the shoulder blades.
- Midriffs must be covered, even when arms are raised.

• Fitted dresses are acceptable as long as they are not too tight. (Once again, remember you will be dancing. You will want to be able to move!)

Dress Approval

Girls must submit a picture of themselves wearing their dress. Boys may submit pictures as well if they need to see if they meet dress standard.

HCS reserves the right to deny entrance to any student, male or female, whose attire or conduct does not meet the above stated requirements.
