### BOYS

Slacks or nice jeans, no tears or rips, collared or button up shirt, or tie-dye T-shirt.

70s-theme clothes are encouraged.

Boots, dress shoes or clean tennis shoes may be worn.

Hats are allowed for this dance.

### GIRLS

Girls - dress or skirts must be mid-knee length please wear shorts underneath; jeans may be worn, but no tears or rips; shirts, including, tie-dye T-shirts, must cover torso, back, chest, and shoulders.

70s-theme clothes are encouraged.

Boots, dress shoes or clean tennis shoes may be worn.

Hats are allowed for this dance.

### PLEASE NOTE:

Modesty is admittedly a subjective interpretation, but one which we have a duty to uphold. Attendees should therefore err on the side of modesty so as to not place chaperones in the difficult position of upholding our dress code standards. We expect nothing less than full cooperation from attendees and parents/guardians on this issue.
