About our classes: Several of our classes have a two or three year rotation. English and English Advanced have a two year rotation with new projects and readings each year so that you can take two years of English and two years of English Advanced for four English credits. You can also use a literature class as an English credit. HS Social Studies alternates between American History one year and World History another year. MS Science has a two year rotation of General Science one year and Physical Science the other year. MS Social Studies alternates between American History one year and Texas History the other year. Advanced HS Science alternates between Biology II (A&P) one year and Physics the next year. Other High School classes may be recommended for upper level or lower level via education websites but in the homeschool arena can be taken in any high school year, so it is not necessary to take Government & Economics as a senior.

In the homeschool community, you have some flexibility in placing your student in classes for which you think she or he is advanced or behind in their studies, rather than going by the age-appropriate grade level. All teachers are willing to consult with you regarding these matters. If you feel your student is behind in math or advanced in science (or other topics) please ask the teacher about placing your student in the class most appropriate for their learning needs.
