

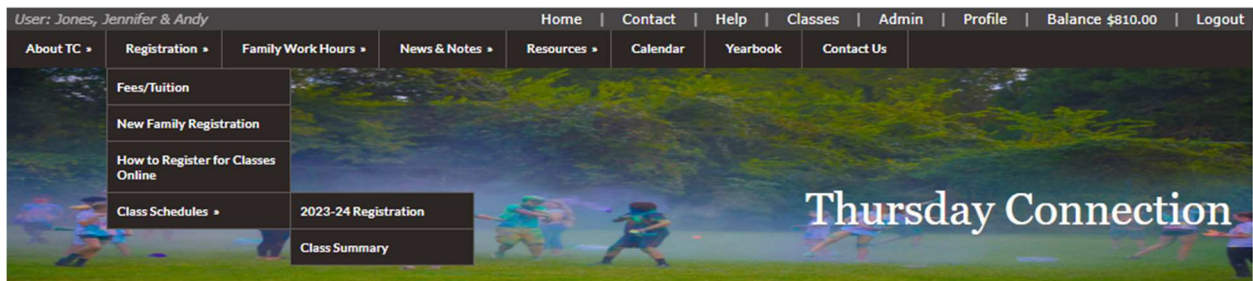
THURSDAY CONNECTION REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

Through physical exercises and techniques, students will gain valuable knowledge and skills in self-defense, discipline, confidence, humility, and self-control. The course is designed to provide training in both aggressive and non-aggressive techniques, exploring the history and philosophy of the martial arts. The course is suitable for students with no previous experience in self-defense, and it aims to equip them with basic skills to handle a range of self-defense situations. The class focuses on both mental and physical aspects of the arts, and students will learn defensive techniques to be used against an attacker, as well as escapes and submissions from various attacks. The course starts with self-defense education geared towards risk awareness, risk reduction, risk recognition, and risk avoidance. The class will then progress to basic self-defense skills that provide the individual with options should they find themselves in a physical confrontation. Upon completion of the course, students will have gained an adequate skill level to handle basic self-defense situations. The course encourages students to develop the discipline, confidence, humility, and self-control that are integral to the philosophy of Gracie Jiu-Jitsu. Course Outcomes and Objectives: Student Learning Outcomes: The student will: 1. Learn basic skills to analyze potentially dangerous situations and implement techniques in order to defuse the situation. 2. Execute escape techniques, joint locks, throws, controlling methods, take downs, and chokes. 3. Demonstrate the proper use of feet and hands as self-defense tools while recognizing proper joint alignment and overall body mechanics and movement. 4. Apply life skill techniques to recognized challenges presented. </div> </div>

Click **Class Summary** and this will take you to the **MANAGE MY REGISTRATIONS** page. Classes will be listed under Class Registrations. Click the remove box for every class you would like to drop. Click **REMOVE**. Use caution while dropping because once a class has been dropped, there is no guarantee you will be able to re-enroll.

Continue registering in this manner. There is no minimum or maximum number of classes. Please email the registrar if you encounter any problems or have any questions.

Important notes when creating your child's schedule:

All students may have one (1) 30-minute lunch period:

K – 5 th	Elementary lunch	11-11:30 a.m.
5 th – 8 th	Middle school lunch	12-12:30 p.m.
9 th – 12 th	High school lunch	1-1:30 p.m.

Students may not have unassigned time during their day at TC. For gaps between classes, they must be signed up for:

- Lunch
- Break Room (3rd -12th, not available during lunch hours)
- Big Kid room (K-2nd grade)
- Library (quiet environment, not available during lunch hours, limited availability)
- Study Hall (quiet environment, only 11:00-12:00 or 12:00-1:00, limited availability)
- Off-Campus

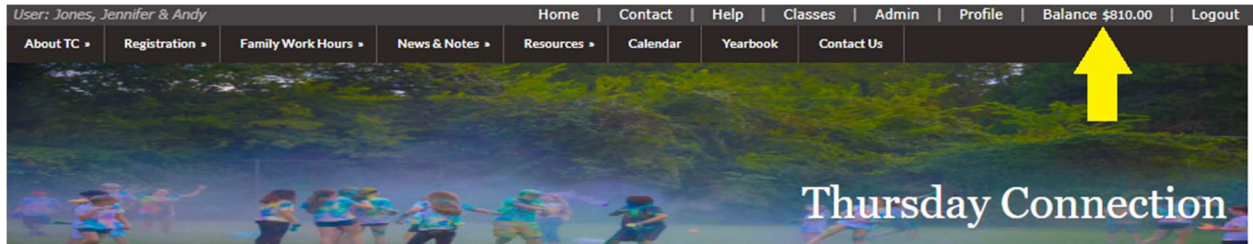
Each student may have one (1) break room period at no cost. Break room is not available during lunch hours. An extra break room period has a \$25 per-semester fee.

Library is unavailable during lunch hours, as that space is needed for students whose parents are working shifts and students with 30-minute music lessons that need a 30-minute spot to be for the remainder of the hour. Library and study hall period have a \$50/semester fee.

IMPORTANT: Once you have finished selecting classes, please email the registrar at registrar@thursdayconnection.org and wait for a confirmation reply that your schedule is finalized and you are cleared to pay. **Do not pay any invoices until you have received confirmation that it is OK to proceed.**



Please pay online by logging in to the TC website and choosing “Balance” at the top of the page:



You may also pay tuition and fees in-person at Thursday Connection on Thursdays.

Paying by check: Checks must be made out to individual teachers. Checks do not require an envelope and can be placed in the **red tuition box** at the check-in table in the entryway near the scanner. A **red tuition box** is also located in the Narthex area in front of the sanctuary. The registrar must process your payment and will ensure your TC account is credited. The registrar will make sure your checks reach the teacher.

Paying with cash: Enclose exact change in a sealed, labeled envelope for each individual teacher. Please do not hand cash directly to teachers. Bring your sealed, labeled envelopes of cash to the registrar outside the sanctuary. The registrar must process your payment and will ensure your TC account is credited. The registrar will make sure your sealed, labeled envelope of cash reaches the teacher.

Please always pay your child's tuition on time. A late fee of \$5 per student, per class, per week will be assessed.
