There have been a few important changes made to the Child Protection Law, effective December 31, 2014. Along with the PA State Police Criminal Record information, and the Child Abuse History certified by the state police that is required for staff and volunteers who work (or apply to work) in direct contact with children and youth, it is now necessary to provide **Federal Criminal History Record information**, with a full set of fingerprints.
