About Your Leadership Team

Your primary homeschool leader is Jenny Novero. As your first tier of leadership, Jenny is the primary decision maker for policy and overall group direction as well as conflict resolution. However, it would be impossible to do any of what we do without the help and support of your CHIEFS leadership team as well as our many wonderful members who pitch in with incredible generosity of time, effort, and ability. With this said, if at any time you need help, prayer, or just have a general concern, please feel free to contact any of us. We serve Christ by serving you.

Code of Conduct

"The father of godly children has cause for joy. What a pleasure to have children who are wise". Proverbs 23:24

CHIEFS is open to all Christian homeschool families, and we always need to remember to maintain a standard that would be consistent with the desires of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. In all that we do, we not only represent CHIEFS, but also CornerStone Christian Fellowship and, most importantly, Jesus Christ. As a result, we ask that all members hold fast to CHIEFS' code of conduct.

Facilities:

CornerStone Christian Fellowship has most graciously allowed us to use the facility and grounds for all of our functions. We do, however, request that the following guide lines be adhered to:

- Please keep the facilities clean by picking up after yourselves and others. <u>Always</u> remember to leave things better than the way you found them!
- CornerStone Christian Academy is subject to routine, unscheduled lock out and lock-down for disaster preparedness drills. Any activities scheduled on the CornerStone campus may be temporarily affected. Leadership will always do its best to keep you informed of these events, but we do ask for your patience and understanding should this drill occur around your event.

RSVPing:

- Please remember that by signing up on the database for any event or activity, you are saying you agree to the date, time, event, location, and **will be present and on time.** Many activities are planned based upon sign ups; Not showing up without proper notification creates a financial burden. Please RSVP responsibly.
- Activity no show/no call policy: After RSVPing for **two** events and then not showing or calling to remove your name from the list prior to the start of the event, you will be suspended from all activities for 3 months. Your second occurrence of two (a total of four) no call/no shows will result in your family being prohibited from activities for 6 months. Your third occurrence (a total of 6 no call/no shows) will result in your family banned from all but parent meetings for a 12 month period. We understand that children become ill at the last minute, cars break down, and other circumstances beyond your control may cause you to miss events. We do expect you to contact us as soon as possible in this case. Each occurrence will be handled on a case by case basis with grace, love, and mercy.

More than anything, we ask that you RSVP responsibly and remember that your actions reflect Christ in everything you do.

Field Trips & Events:

- Out of courtesy and respect for other peoples' time, and in an effort to best reflect our group and Christ, all participants of field trips are required to show up ten minutes prior to start time. We often cannot wait for late arrivals; please make sure you allot sufficient time to arrive at the designated meeting point.
- Many of our field trips are hosted by businesses. Please educate your child(ren) ahead of time of the following requirements:
 - 1. Quiet voices
 - 2. No running or climbing
 - 3. No destruction of landscaping
 - 4. In constant supervision by parent
- The primary purpose of field trips is for educational experiences. Parents and children will be expected to give full attention and respect to the host/docent. We have many activities outside of educational field trips for fellowshipping and conversing.
- Any field trips or activities that require a significant financial burden to CHIEFS (in excess of \$5 per participant) are expected to be paid up front and in full. <u>If</u> payment is not received by the deadline, your name will be removed from the list and the next person on the call list will be contacted to take your place.
- We understand that sometimes events beyond our control can cause us to be late to an event or miss it entirely. However, in the case of this occurrence in a prepaid event, a refund cannot and will not be afforded.
- **No** official CHIEFS function may be held without authorization of primary leadership.
- We encourage and welcome all members to assist & volunteer in established CHIEFS events. However, in order to lead an activity, class, etc. on CornerStone's campus, in addition to being approved by leadership, membership of six months is required. If you have any questions regarding this policy, please contact leadership.
- Graduated CHIEFS Alumni may, at leadership's discretion, still participate in CHIEFS events.
- Membership in CHIEFS for a minimum of **one year** is required before approval will be given to host an event involving children in your home.

Dress Code:

• While trusting your judgment in clothing will be appropriate and reflect our Christian views and values, we specifically ask that there be no articles of clothing advertising alcohol, tobacco, or sexually explicit material worn at any time.

Behavior:

- In all interactions, language should be kept respectful, appropriate and profanity free.
- Children **must** be supervised at all times for everyone's safety.
- We ask that appropriate manners be used. Treat others respectfully and be courteous at all times. We should always remember we are not only representing the CHIEFS group and CornerStone Christian Fellowship, but most importantly, Jesus Christ.
- Leadership reserves the right to correct children demonstrating inappropriate behavior at CHIEFS events.
- We understand that many families have children of various ages that may not be able to participate in an age restrictive event. Families are welcome to stay during the event. However, children must be in **constant** parental supervision and both children and parents should be non-disruptive. Out of respect for the event leaders and participants, families may be asked to leave an event if noise or behavior becomes a distraction to the event.
- CornerStone Christian Academy is a secure campus, therefore, identification cards **MUST** be worn **AT ALL TIMES**. Pictures for ID cards will be taken at the beginning of the school year. Initial ID cards will be provided free of charge however, replacement cards will be issued at a cost of two dollars each.
- If and when a problem arises with either leadership or other members, please address your concerns to those directly involved in the situation. If an agreement cannot be reached between the parties, please mutually contact the CHIEFS group leader. If an agreement cannot be reached through this means, leadership reserves the right to include pastoral counsel. If it comes to leadership's attention that there is a history of strife between any applicant, pending member, or current member, it is our policy that each person must attend a meeting with leadership to assure there has been resolution between all parties involved. Strife, gossip, and dissention <u>will not</u> be tolerated.

Membership:

- All memberships are conditional upon attending one meeting within the first sixty days of applying to the group. Nursing children are always welcome in parent meetings, however, we must stress that older children may not participate in parent meetings. Childcare is often available for a nominal fee. If this condition poses a hardship on your family, you may contact leadership and request a private meeting with us.
- The cost of CHIEFS membership is \$40 per school year. This is a nonrefundable membership fee per school year payable within Thirty days after joining CHIEFS. Our annual CHIEFS budget and accounts are always available for each member's review.
- Once becoming a member of CHIEFS, your email, telephone number and physical address will become part of our database. As membership to CHIEFS gives you access to this database, we cannot exclude you from it. We are extending our trust to you and are asking to be trusted in return.
- Leadership reserves the right to require a private meeting with any member to resolve private matters.
- Leadership will moderate all group emails and may remove any post from the CHIEFS website it feels does not comply with the spirit of this membership agreement.
- Failure to abide by the code of conduct and standards stated herein may result in individuals being asked to leave the CHIEFS group.

Official CHIEFS Policy on Alternative Lifestyles

Promoting any sinful lifestyle is not acceptable in our organization. We do not stand in judgment of others' sin as we are all born with a sinful nature. **Romans 3:23** "For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God"

We do, however, take a firm stand against all sin and any teaching that would promote it as acceptable. The Bible is our authority on this as the Word of God.

Colossians 3:5 "Put to death whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry." **3:8** "Now you must rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips."

1 Corinthians 6:19 "Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body."
