## **If the wording on our Savers Fundraiser Flyer seems confusing, try reading this!**

**ALL ITEMS MUST BE IN GOOD, CLEAN and SELLABLE/WORKABLE CONDITION**

**ITEMS THAT MUST BE BAGGED UP:** SHARE earns 20 cents per pound

\*Men's, Women's & Children's clothing – shoes, shirts, shorts, pants, coats, pajamas, robes

\*Accessories - clothing, hats, mittens, scarves, ties, socks, purses, wallets, backpacks, bags

\*Other textiles – bath towels, sheets, blankets, pillows, curtains, tablecloths

**ITEMS TO BE BOXED UP:** SHARE earns 10 cents per pound

**PLEASE NOTE!➔** Individual items must be 18 inches or smaller – a general guideline is, *if it would fit inside of a copy paper sized box, we can accept it\*\**

\*Small electrical items – toasters, radios, power tools, irons, blenders, mixers, stereos, CD players, speakers, DVD and VCR players, lamps

\*Exercise and Outdoor – golf accessories (no clubs), garden tools, sports/exercise equipment

\*Kitchen – pots, pans, utensils, china cups, vases, dishes, cutlery, glassware, silverware, stemware

\*Knick-knacks – jewelry, crafts, mugs, candles, pictures/frames, baskets, ornaments, hand tools.

\*Kids – toys, games, puzzles, stuffed animals
