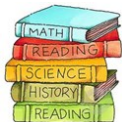

**Homelink's** core classes operate as "college models," allowing students to come to class for one period per week, accomplish their study for that class at home, then return the following week to review their work and move to the next lesson in the class -- the same model followed by most college classes. Each class period is scheduled for 1.5 hours. We also offer a number of enrichment classes for those in the younger grades. These classes are usually one hour and do not involve a lot of homework.
