The fall semester classes conclude the week of **Thursday, December 12 and Tuesday, December 17 (the snow day make-up class)**. If you are moving your child(ren) to a different class, please email Cort and let him know the change. If you are not returning for the spring semester, please notify Cort via email as well.
