

## 2022-23 LEARN Illness Policy

In order to protect all of our families, please follow these guidelines in regard to illness:

Individuals must be free of the following symptoms for 24 hours before they can participate in LEARN activities: fever above 99.6 (without Tylenol or similar medication), diarrhea or vomiting, severe sore throat, continuous coughing or blowing nose (related to active illness), undiagnosed rash or skin lesions, and red, itching eyes with discharge.

COVID-19 Guidelines: LEARN follows the current CDC COVID-19 Guidelines, please familiarize yourself with those [at this link](#).

Communicable Illness: If a communicable illness is diagnosed (COVID-19, strep throat, chicken pox, pink eye, lice, scabies, impetigo, etc.), please notify a Board member, SCENE/West Coordinator, and/or another point of contact volunteer as soon as possible. Follow physician's/health guidelines for return to LEARN activities.

All member families must sign LEARN's Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability form and Personal Responsibility Agreement when applying to join and/or renew their membership in LEARN.

Repeated violation of this policy or knowingly exposing others to communicable illness may result in consequences as outlined in LEARN's Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability at the discretion of board leadership.
