- > The Elementary Program is not a drop-off. Parents must stay on campus and either help in the class or volunteer elsewhere. Parents requiring nursery care may organize their own co-op time.
- > Middle School parents are required to be on campus until students have demonstrated that they can successfully navigate the day with independent self-government and decorum.
- ➤ All families with students in 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades are required to volunteer regularly.
- Fees: Registration fee is \$25 per student, capped at \$75 per family. Technology fee is \$10 per family. 85-minute classes are \$260/year. 1-hour classes are \$200/year. Elementary program is \$275/year. Class fees are due at registration. Supplies fees differ with each class and are due at registration.
