Description:

This class qualifies as a High School Science Class, Humanities Class, or may be used as an elective. The goal of this class is to study the scientific discipline of psychology from a Christian/Biblical view.

This class will prepare a student for college, and/or give them background information so that they can have a Godly foundation and an understanding of psychology. We cover the basics of modern psychology and how it was developed from a non Biblical worldview and then incorporate psychology from a Biblical worldview.

If a student plans to attend college, they will most likely have to take some type of psychology class. Not only will most college professors not have a Biblical/Christian view, but oftentimes will ridicule anything from a Christian perspective. This class will help students recognize and refute many modern psychologists' philosophical assumptions, such as: naturalism, behaviorism, humanism, moral relativism, etc., while providing reasoned explanations from a Christian/Biblical worldview.

Students should expect to spend 1-3 hours each week on homework.
