### Course Objectives:

- Explore and learn about **all seven continents** and many countries and regions around the world.
- Compare how children and families live in different regions and notice cultural similarities and differences.
- Think critically about what has been learned through optional extension activities and review questions.
- See **God as Creator** of the world and reflect on lessons through a Christian perspective included in every lesson.

### Course Components:

- In class introductions to key concepts and focus on worldview encounters for the upcoming week.
- Reading from textbook and gazette (5 lessons per week)
- Complete **10 question review after each lesson in their notebook.**
- Complete notebook assignments to reflect on worldview incorporations
- In-class discussions and activities.
- Weekly quizzes and Unit tests

This course is a high school course that helps students understand the physical features of the earth, world cultures, and how geography influences history, economics, and current events. Students study regions of the world through engaging readings, map work, and case studies while developing practical geography skills. The course is written from a Christian worldview and encourages students to see the world as God's creation and people as uniquely valuable.
