Course Syllabus

Course Objectives:

- Recognize art as a gift and reflection of our Creator God
- Encourage personal creative artistic expression
- Cultivate appreciation for great artists and their contributions
- Explore various art media, specifically those with Medieval roots (Illuminated initial, mosaics, stained glass, embossed metal/foil)

Course Components:

- Tailored visual presentation of instructional materials encouraging student interaction
- An Art Journal to be maintained at home and discussed in class
- Application of presented concepts through various art projects
- Purposeful development of character traits such as focus, persistence, encouragement, and cooperation through hands-on activities

This non-graded course will explore and reinforce art themes in tandem with Koinonia History this year, which surveys the Medieval time period.

Course Materials:

- Students will need an old oversized (adult) t-shirt to use as a cover-up to protect their clothing for some art activities. Please have their name printed on the back. It will be sent home to be cleaned, as needed.
- An Art Journal (sketchbook) will be purchased by Koinonia for each child and will be theirs to keep at the end of the school year. This will be used at home and brought to class for sharing and discussion. A suggested donation of \$2 per child would be greatly appreciated.
- A pouch or box with student's name containing pencils (colored and regular), glitter pens, markers, and/or crayons for use in class for with the Art Journal at home.
