



# EverBloom Homeschool Co-Op Class Descriptions 2026-2027 Semester One



**CLASS:** Preschool/Kindergarten Class

**AGES:** 3 - 5 yrs. old

**CLASS TIME:** Tuesdays from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm

**INSTRUCTOR:** Mrs. Ashley Alanis

**DESCRIPTION:** This 3-hour preschool/kindergarten class focuses on getting our youngest school-aged kids comfortable in a group setting. We will begin each day with 30 minutes of movement in our most open workshop space with fun whole-body activities. Throughout the next 2 ½ hours, children will work on letters of the week and basic math (numbers and counting), preparing for snack time, practicing manners, taking turns, and having conversations during snack. Every class, children will listen to a story or two and complete a seasonal or holiday craft or science experiment that ties into the lesson of the day. Children will also have an opportunity for free play, and they may choose to play with peers or independently during that time.

No knowledge base is expected and all levels will be accommodated.

**CLASS INFO:** The semester fee includes all regular supplies. There may be times where I ask you to bring in a specific item for your child to help with a craft (ex: mason jar). Parents will need to pack a snack and drink every Tuesday for snack time. Parents will also need to volunteer each semester to help in the classroom. The number of times per semester will be determined by how many children are enrolled. There will be a sign up sheet for classroom volunteers. Children must be toilet independent, or a parent will be asked to assist their child with bathroom needs.

**CLASS:** RoboThink Robotics

**AGES:** 6-12 years old

**CLASS TIME:** Tuesdays from 10:00 am - 11:00 am

**INSTRUCTOR:** Mrs. Stephanie Noland

**DESCRIPTION:** Calling all aspiring engineers! Welcome to the exciting world of RoboThink, where the thrill of robotics meets the wonders of your student's imagination! Prepare to be amazed as students embark on an immersive program that lets them construct a wide collection of themed robots. From playful dogs with wagging tails to astonishing vehicles that can move on their own, this program will ignite their imaginations like never before! Along the way, participants will learn the essential skills of working with mainboards, DC motors, gears, and axles, unlocking the secrets of robotic creation. Join us on this wild adventure and watch your robotic creations come to life—no prior robotics experience necessary!

We will rotate through a variety of exciting robotic themes such as Amusement Park Tycoon, Expedition Mars, and Battle Robots, to name a few! Your student will explore a variety of robotic builds and techniques.

We take pictures and videos during class to capture the experience and memorialize your student's creation (shared via a private group Google drive folder). Parents will also be invited in the class for the last 10-15 minutes to see their student's robot in action!

**DESCRIPTION:** Turn your big ideas into a real business with RoboThink Spark Tank! In this exciting class, students will create their own company from scratch—designing a name, logo, business plan, and more. Along the way, they'll explore stories of successful kid entrepreneurs, learn the essentials of starting a business, and discover what it takes to bring their ideas to life. Get ready to think like a boss and launch your own business adventure!

Students will work in small teams to create a business plan over the course of the semester, and parents will be invited to attend a capstone event on the last day—where student groups will have an opportunity to share their business ideas!

**CLASS:** Mixed Media Art Exploration I

**AGES:** 6-10 years old

**DESCRIPTION:** This engaging art class is designed for students between 6 to 10 years old. Over the semester, students will explore various art techniques and styles through the use of mixed media, including chalk, pencil, pen, and watercolor. Students will gain skills that they can later use on more advanced art projects.

Students will have the opportunity to develop their skills, experiment with different media, and create unique artworks in a supportive and inspiring environment.

**CLASS:** Mixed Media Art Exploration II

**AGES:** 11+ years old

**CLASS TIME:** Tuesdays from 10:00 am - 11:00 am

**INSTRUCTOR:** Mrs. Annie Alvarez

**DESCRIPTION:** This engaging art class is designed for 11 years and older or those with previous art experience. Over the semester, students will explore various art techniques and styles through the use of mixed media, including chalk, sculpture, and a unique "Meet the Artist" unit where students learn about a renowned artist and create pieces inspired by their style.

Students will have the opportunity to develop their skills, experiment with different mediums, and create unique artworks in a supportive and inspiring environment.

The focus in Mixed Media Exploration II is chalk art techniques, pencil and simple sketching, acrylic and watercolor, hands-on sculpture project and pinch pots, "Meet the Artist" unit blending art history with creative practice.

**AGES:** 7-14 years old

**CLASS TIME:** Tuesdays from 10:00 am - 11:00 am

**INSTRUCTOR:** Ms. Erina Johnson

**DESCRIPTION:** Discover the ecosystem of artistry, skill, and collaboration that brings a play to life! Every student will learn the fundamentals of Classical Acting and gain experience in technical design (lights, sound, costumes) before taking on one of many creative roles in our final

production on the last day of class. In this class, students learn the value of teamwork, especially understanding that being “a star” is not based on visibility, study art as a discipline, and gain practice skills they can apply to any subject.

**CLASS INFO:** If there are 10 or more students, a decision to bring in a second teacher will be made based on student experience levels, age ranges, and total students enrolled.
