FORTITUDE SPEECH & DEBATE CLUB

Fortitude Speech and Debate is a local Christian homeschool forensics club within the Stoa league. We are a group of parents who train our homeschooled students aged 12-18 to hone their communication skills for the glory of God. Our primary vision is to disciple our children and develop Godly character in them through the vehicle of competition by training them in “Speaking boldly. Changing the world for Christ,” which is also Stoa’s motto.

Our club meets on Tuesday evenings at Trinity Community Church and is parent-led in a co-op style. While each parent is their own student’s primary coach, we come together as a club to sharpen one another’s skills and to provide the benefit of accountability (so that things get DONE). Because parents are integral to the coaching team, our club is not a drop-off event. With this in mind, we do provide training for both parents and students as well as referrals to pro-coaches which you may privately engage. Because discipleship is our primary purpose, we offer an apologetics bible study each week, which we encourage all our club members to attend, regardless of whether they intend to compete in the apologetics event.

Our club offers all of the Stoa events: Team Policy Debate, Lincoln-Douglas Value Debate, Parliamentary Debate, interpretive speeches (bringing to life a selection of literature), Apologetics (defending the Christian faith), Extemporaneous (analysis of current events), Mars Hill (building bridges between culture and Biblical truth), and platform speeches (in which students inform their audience), *so long as we have a parent to head up that area of interest.*

Students can choose a-la-carte style which event(s) they will invest their energy. Speech and debate do take time and perseverance to do well, and we have found that students/families get out what they put in. Because competition is an excellent motivator, we do expect our students to commit to a minimum of two tournaments each year. The tournament calendar is posted on Stoa’s website and there are always plenty of tournaments in California (including our own local tournament).

HIGH SCHOOL ENRICHMENT

HIGH SCHOOL ENRICHMENT: STATE CENTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT (SCCCD) – DUAL ENROLLMENT

The State Center Community College High School Enrichment program offers students in the 10th, 11th, and 12th grades an opportunity to enroll in college courses and receive college credit. Exceptions to this policy are outlined in the High School Enrichment application.

Generally, courses of a remedial nature, courses for which failing grades were earned, and courses required for high school graduation do not meet the intent and spirit of the program. Students must meet all the necessary prerequisites for any course in which they wish to enroll. Students admitted to the program are treated as new students each semester attended; and are eligible to register during the open enrollment period.

BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAM

- The ability to get ahead and earn college credit while still in High School.
- No tuition costs - Student is responsible for books and materials required for the course.

ELIGIBILITY

- A student may qualify for the program with a cumulative high school GPA of at least a 2.5 (Juniors and Seniors) and a 3.0 (Sophomores).
- Approval from the high school principal, a high school counselor, and a parent ARE REQUIRED.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- High school students must begin the process with their high school counselor.
- State Center Community College District (SCCCD) Admission Application is available October 1st for spring, & April 1 for summer/fall. (Please note - An online Admission Application is only needed for new students to the High School Enrichment program. Students who've participated in the previous semester do not need to complete this application.)
- High School Enrichment application with all required signatures (each school has their own). Your high school counselor must assist you in the selection of your requested course(s). This application is required for each term you wish to take a course.
- A current and complete High School Transcript.
- FERPA release form (included in application packet) is required before a student can register for classes.
- Bring or email completed application and all supporting documents to the Student Services Office at the community college.
- Once your application has been approved by the college, it is **your** responsibility to go to the Admissions and Records Office to register for your courses. Not all courses listed in the schedule are available to High School Enrichment students. Email submissions may be accepted.
