General Policies and Information

Overview

Discovery classes are for enrichment. Students are not required to complete homework unless stated in the course description at the time of registration. Classes include instruction and hands-on activities. A variety of topics is offered and may include art, music, science, history, literature, geography, or other subjects. At lunch time, all Discovery children participate in a P.E. class or the younger children are given playground time.

Discovery (K-6) fees: Each semester, students pay a fee which includes a \$15 donation to our Host Church for hosting our co-op classes. Fees are as follows:

\$45 K-6 student taking 3-4 classes

\$35 K-6 student taking 1-2 classes

*Family Discount: Families with 3 or more children in Discovery **or** Excel are given a discount on the fees for the 3rd, 4th, etc. child.*

\$30 K-6 student taking 3-4 classes

\$25 K-6 student taking 1-2 classes

Pre-K and Nursery Fees: Each semester, all nursery and pre-k children pay the \$15 donation to our Host Church for hosting our co-op classes. Pre-K children who participate in the Pre-K class also pay a \$15 fee to help cover class costs.

Excel classes are core classes. ***Students are expected to do homework and are expected to meet the requirements of each course.*** Transitions classes (7th-8th grade) will generally spend 1-2 hours per week outside of class on each course. Excel classes (9th-12th) will generally spend 3-4 hours per week outside of class for each 1-credit course.

Excel (7-12) fees: Each semester, students pay a \$25 administrative fee that includes a \$15 donation to our Host Church for hosting our co-op classes, as well as a \$10 Admin fee. Individual class fees generally range from \$10 - \$50 per semester depending on the expenses each teacher expects to have. *Curriculum materials are additional.*

Family Discount: Families with 3 or more children in Excel are given a discount on the admin fees for the 3rd, 4th, etc. child.

This discount is allowed to be combined with the Discovery/Excel Family Discount for the 3+ student(s) in Discovery

Parents also pay a \$15 building fee (for the on-campus parent only).

Location

Both Excel and Discovery classes are held at our host church in Sanford, FL.

Co-op Team

General Policies

You must be a current member of NHE to participate in Co-op.

Serving

A parent is required to serve a certain number of hours depending on the number of classes your children are participating in. Usually it is less than 3 hours, however; we are a cooperative. That means *you may be asked to serve more if help is needed*, so we need you to be available if needs arise.

Please plan to be on campus the entire time your child is on campus – We are not a drop-off program.

Each week, an updated schedule is sent out over the weekend and posted again Monday morning on site with any needed changes.

In to the required serving hours, all parents are required to complete a cleaning task before they leave for the day. This requires either opening or closing *regardless of the times your child is taking classes*.

If you are not attending co-op for a full day and will not be on campus at 3pm to complete a closing cleaning task, you will be required to help open at 9 am on Discovery weeks.

Communication

Most communication occurs by email. Please check your email daily. All families participating in Co-op must be registered on the nearhim.com website. When registering on the website, select the following email groups:

Teacher Employment

Discovery/Excel does not employ instructors. We are a Co-op at which instructors and students can convene, providing assistance for homeschool enrichment. *Teachers with a child participating in either Co-op do not receive compensation.* Occasionally, classes may be offered by outside instructors and they are under the employ of the families who have a student attending his/her class. Parents pay the teachers directly. However, the Co-op Team does maintain supervisory authority.

Childcare

Childcare is available in the Nursery for babies and preschool children (who are not in the Pre-K class) *ONLY when a participating parent is helping or teaching.*

When the parent is not helping or teaching, the child must remain with the parent. This also applies to any Discovery children who do not have a class. Study Hall is provided for students in 7th – 12th grades only.

Sickness

We want you to take care of yourself, and we want to stay healthy! If over the weekend, you think you, the parent, may not be able to come to class, you will be expected to contact the person who is overseeing call outs. Teachers are asked to connect with their helpers about covering their classes.

Dress Code

Because parents and students will be participating in a variety of activities, including physical education classes, science labs, games, etc., we require everyone to wear clothes appropriate to the day's activities. As Discovery and Excel meet just one day a week (with an occasional field trip), we hope you do not see this request as unreasonable. By participating in Co-op, your family (parents and students) agrees to comply with the following dress code at Monday classes and all co-op activities.

- My attire will not have words or images on them that dishonor Christ
- Shirts must have sleeves/straps measuring at least 3 fingers wide with a modest neckline
- Shorts/Skirts must be at or below the fingers with no writing on the back
- Pants must be worn at the waist
- Hats will be taken off in class
- Closed toed shoes are required of all students participating in physical education classes and some science classes as requested by the teacher.

Do Not Bring...

Skateboards or any devices with wheels, pocket knives or other weapons. MP3 players, cell phones, and laptops may be brought to co-op, but not be seen during class time without permission from the teacher. Students not complying with this request, may be asked to leave the classroom.

Disciplinary Guidelines

Character is just as important to us, in fact more important, than what our students are studying in class. We work hard to make co-op a positive environment for children and parents. Please speak with a Co-op Team member if you have any questions.

Weather Cancellations

In case of bad weather (hurricanes, etc.), listen to your local radio or TV station for school closings. Discovery classes will be canceled if Seminole County Schools are closed or delayed. Information on make-up classes or changes to the schedule will be sent by email.

Withdrawal

If it is necessary for you to withdraw from co-op before the end of the year, any fees paid will not be refunded.
