Building Usage & Parent Responsibilities

- I agree to comply with the following Bethesda Lutheran Church Building usage requirements. (Note: The usage of the church is a great benefit to our group, and not to be misused. PARENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE for the behavior and discipline of their children during all HomeStars functions.)
- Show respect and appreciation to all members, children, presenters, and BLBC staff.
 - All **rooms** need to be left in the same condition as upon arrival.
 - Do not take **church items** (tables, chairs, toys, etc.) from other rooms without prior permission.
 - Do not use **sound equipment** without a trained person present.
 - Do not use any **rooms** that are not reserved for HomeStars activities.
 - Children are prohibited from playing in the **sanctuary**.
 - No unsupervised children in **hallways** or running in hallways.
 - All children on the **playground** must be supervised at all times.
 - The **gym** is not available unless it has been reserved by HomeStars.
 - The **church building** is a place of worship and needs to be treated with dignity and respect.
 - When using the **kitchen**, I agree to clean up and leave the facilities in the same condition as upon arrival.

- I agree HomeStars and Bethesda Lutheran Church (BLBC) are not responsible for the **loss or theft** of personal belongings.

Inappropriate:

- I agree that the HomeStars Steering Committee and/or church representatives reserve the right to ask anyone attending the HomeStars activities to leave if their behavior, attitude, speech, or attire is deemed inappropriate at any given time. Smoking, drugs, and alcohol are strictly prohibited at HomeStars activities. Clothing is required to be modest and without offensive slogans or graffiti. Music should be Christian/non-offensive.

Liability:

- I agree to assume all responsibility for my child(ren) while he/she/they are participating in any and all HomeStars activities. I also agree to accept any and all financial responsibility for any medical and/or legal expenses that may occur due to taking part in any activity. All HomeStars members and BLBC personnel shall be exempt from any/all legal action or financial responsibility due to any injury that may occur during HomeStars activities. **NOTE: All activities (unless otherwise noted) are intended for the family; children must be under parent supervision. If you need to leave the premises, approval must be given by a member of the Steering Committee, and you must designate another parent to be in charge of your child(ren) while you are gone. Only extenuating circumstances will be considered.**
- HomeStars' operations are to be in accordance with Bethesda Lutheran Brethren Church's doctrine (including the Church of Lutheran Brethren's Core Values and Position Papers noted at www.clba.org/about). Persons in leadership, teaching, and/or volunteer roles in any HomeStars class or activity agree to keep doctrinal and value differences from dividing our group or teaching anything contrary to BLBC Statement of Faith and CLBA Core Value and Position Papers. With that in mind, I agree to protect the unity and ministry of HomeStars by keeping our focus on Christian homeschooling encouragement and celebrating our oneness in Christ.
