The ACEL rule governing the eligibility of students to participate in athletics will be followed and enforced. It is important that all of our parents understand and abide by this rule:

“For the purposes of participation on a ACEL home education athletic association team, a homeschool student-athlete must spend 51% of their class time in the home setting, unless the student-athlete is a graduating senior, in which case he or she may spend up to 66% of their class time outside the home setting. Any student taking classes through a state approved public school, virtual school, charter school, a co-operative school, or any blending of such that will result in the student receiving a diploma from such school, does not meet the definition of a ACEL homeschooled student.”

Thus hired teaching in a cooperative setting cannot make up over 49% of the student’s school time.
