

# What does it cost to be a member of SMIC Academy?

## Enrollment Fees

- New Family registration - \$40.00/one child or max \$60.00/family

OR

- Returning Family Re-enrollment fee - \$20/family (waived if filed by April 30 and files are up-to-date)

## Tuition

- Tuition - \$200 (can be divided equally over 10 months; or \$10 discount if paid in full by Aug 1)

- High School (8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>) Supplemental Fee - \$100/year/family (added to tuition arrangements above)

## Other Fees

- Alabama Christian Education Assoc. (ACEA) Dues - \$21.00/year/child; paid to SMICA

- Premiers support program (1<sup>st</sup> two years of homeschooling with the Academy if family has 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> graders) - \$35.00/year

- New student fee for existing family - \$20 per student

- Graduation Fee - \$35 per graduate

## Other Financial Requirements

- Home School Legal Defense Association dues (group rate \$115.00/year/family, paid to HSLDA)

- Achievement Testing (every other year, 4<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup>) - \$25 with SMICA, or up to \$75 depending on source

## Avoidable Fees

- Late monthly payment - \$10

- Unexcused absence from faculty meeting - \$10

- Incomplete end-of-year files (June 30 for 8<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup>; July 31<sup>st</sup> for 1<sup>st</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>) - \$10/child/1<sup>st</sup> month; \$5/2<sup>nd</sup> month; etc.

- Incomplete beginning-of-year files (due 4<sup>th</sup> Sat in Aug) - \$10/child/1<sup>st</sup> month; \$5/2<sup>nd</sup> month; etc.

- Transcript Rush fees <7 days - \$15 (or \$30 for transcripts that need to be updated)

- Withdrawal fees after July 1 - \$20 per student (except for providential circumstances)

## Discounts Available (one per family)

- \$10 – if tuition, high school supp fee, and ACEA dues are paid by Aug 1<sup>st</sup>.

- \$50 – if you qualify as a pastor or a support-raising missionary

- \$100 – 200 – for returning families, if you are filling one of the servant roles in SMICA

Premiers	35
<b>Total due to SMICA</b>	<b>\$ 296</b>
HSLDA dues	115
Achievement Test (not due yet)	0
<b>Grand Total</b>	<b>\$ 411</b>

Example #3:

Returning family, 2 enrolled children  
(4<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade)

Re-enrollment (filed early)	\$ 0
Tuition	200
High school supplement	0
ACEA dues (\$21 x 2 children)	42
Premiers	0
<b>Total due to SMICA</b>	<b>\$ 242</b>
HSLDA dues	115
Achievement Test (completed last year)	0
<b>Grand Total</b>	<b>\$ 357</b>

Example #2:

New family, 4 enrolled children  
(4<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> grade)

New Family Registration	\$ 60
Tuition	200
High school supplement	100
ACEA dues (\$21 x 4 children)	84
Premiers	0
<b>Total due to SMICA</b>	<b>\$ 444</b>
HSLDA dues	115
Achievement Test (4 <sup>th</sup> , 7 <sup>th</sup> , 9 <sup>th</sup> grader)	75
<b>Grand Total</b>	<b>\$ 634</b>

Example #4:

Returning family, 2 enrolled children  
(10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade)

Re-enrollment (filed in June)	\$ 20
Tuition	200
High school supplement	100
ACEA dues (\$21 x 2 children)	42
Graduation Fee	35
<b>Total due to SMICA</b>	<b>\$ 397</b>
HSLDA dues	115
Achievement Test (waived, sub with PSAT )	25
<b>Grand Total</b>	<b>\$ 537</b>
