### Statement of Faith

## **Admissions Philosophy and Basic Information**

Seeds of Faith Co-op is an enrichment cooperative designed to be a blessing to families who live an educational life and who are committed to knowing God, fellow man and nature. We have 4 classes in a day, and all the moms and/or dads will be assigned to a classroom to teach or assist in a class. Other jobs may be serving as a hall monitor, helping to clean, or serving in the nursery/toddler/Pre-K areas. Each family is expected to do their part to help our co-op run smoothly.

Our classes are structured so that parents who have been at co-op for longer than a semester will teach a class to help fill our schedule. We typically ask for suggestions of classes in order to best meet the needs of our families. Some of our classes include core subjects such as science, history, math, reading or writing. Although these are core subjects, they will require additional work at home to fulfill a full credit for the semester/year. Other classes are more electives such as art, PE, and various other topics. Classes change each semester, so check the page to see the current classes being offered.

### Fall Semester

We have a Fall Semester that runs 10 weeks for everyone and 12 weeks for advanced classes. An advanced class is 12 weeks long and will be considered a Core Class. Typically these classes are only for middle or high school students. The advanced classes will begin 2 weeks prior to the original start date and are often a 2-semester class, meaning it will take place in Fall and Spring. Our Fall semester begins the Monday after Labor Day and ends the Monday of the week before Thanksgiving. We do not take a fall break. Registration for Fall classes will take place in July.

### Spring Semester

Our Spring Semester runs 10 weeks as well and 12 weeks for advanced classes and typically runs mid-February through early May. We do take off a week for Spring break and this is typically the first full week in April, however, it is subject to change so please check with us if you are planning a vacation or trip. Registration for Spring Classes will take place in January.

To maintain the ideal atmosphere, we ask that all of our students and families adhere to our statement of faith and the student code of conduct which has been developed in order to fulfill this mission of a positive environment. - Am I willing to invest in all the children I come in contact with? Relationships are key within a living education. Because this community is “for the children’s sake,” we are asking that you consider and invest in all the children participating.
- Am I willing to participate with a servant’s heart, a learner’s mentality and with a gracious attitude toward all involved?
- Am I willing to regularly pray for another family and go out of my way to make everyone feel welcomed and included?

The board is committed to reading and praying over all completed applications. Placement will be decided based upon congruence with our educational philosophy, space available, order applications were received and Holy Spirit leading.
