



RISE Homework Policy

Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might. Ecclesiastes 9:10

RISE is designed to enable Christian parents to train up their children in the ways of the Lord. Hard work is a gift from God that teaches steadfastness, diligence, and perseverance. According to the Scriptures, those who learn these character traits while they are young will reap good habits and be satisfied with a lifetime of rewarding achievements. With this principle in mind, RISE challenges students to fulfill their academic responsibilities in order to reach their full God-given potential.

Students are expected to complete RISE homework assignments on time and with integrity. Parents must be willing to oversee homework completion at home. Completed homework assignments will be checked or collected in class in accordance with each RISE instructor's methods of record keeping. Weekly homework completion is mandatory and a prerequisite for classroom participation.

RISE supports parents whose students temporarily cannot fulfill homework responsibilities due to sickness, travel, or transformative life events. In these cases, parents should email each RISE instructor involved. RISE instructors will then re-set due dates or re-define the workload as is appropriate for each situation.

Habitual unexcused homework incompleteness will result in an instructor-parent notification out of concern for the student's academic well-being. Out of the same concerns, families of students with failing scores must meet with Directors and the teacher of the class to discuss options for success and to give the student a final opportunity to turn in missing work. Unless improvement is made by the end of a failed semester, the student will be withdrawn from the class with no reimbursement and will be blocked from Registration the following year.

As part of the registration process and in order to be accepted into the RISE program, this form must be signed by the enrolled student and a parent and uploaded to the RISE website or handed into the RISE teachers on or before the first day of class.

The following verses may be useful for families studying the character trait of diligence: Proverbs 10:4, 12:14, 13:4, 14:23, 21:5, Ecclesiastes 9:10, and Galatians 6:9.
