

Statement of Faith

Axxess Co-op does not require students or parents to sign a statement of faith. It is, however, our intent to provide our children with a distinctly Christian worldview within the class rooms so our tutors must sign our Statement of Faith. While we may hold to denominational differences, we follow the following statements that are a good summary of the fundamental religious beliefs that are at the core of the ministry and operation of this homeschool co-op.

We believe that the Bible with its 66 books of the Old and New Testaments stand alone as the inspired, inerrant, and authoritative Word of God, the supreme and final authority for all faith and life (2 Tim. 3:15-17, 2 Pet. 1:20-21).

We believe that there is but one God eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, who is perfect, holy, and sovereign; the Creator, Preserver, and Ruler of all things (Gen.1:1, Mt. 28:19, Jn. 10:30, 2 Cor. 13:14, I John 5:7, Ps. 18:30).

We believe in the deity and humanity of our Lord Jesus Christ who is the only begotten Son of God (Jn. 10:30, Phil. 2:5-8), in His virgin birth (Mt. 1:23), in His sinless life (Heb. 4:15, (2 Corinthians 5:21; 1 John 3:5), in His miracles (Jn 2:11 & 23), in His atoning death through His shed blood (1 John 2:2, 1 Cor. 15:3, Eph. 1:7, John 3:16-18), in His bodily resurrection (Jn. 11:25, 1 Cor. 15:4&14), in His ascension to the right hand of the Father (Mk. 16:19, Acts 1:9), and in His personal and physical return in power and glory (Acts 1:11, Rev. 19:11, I Thess. 4:16-17).

We believe in the literal 7 day Biblical account of creation as set forth in Genesis 1 and 2.

We believe that man was originally created in the image of God but, because of the temptation of Satan, sinned against God and is therefore lost and separated from God. The only way one can be saved from eternal death and restored to God is by placing his faith in the saving work of Jesus Christ alone (Gen. 1:26, Gen. 3, Rom. 3:19-28).

We believe that salvation is the gift of God brought to man by grace and is received by personal faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, whose substitutionary death on the cross paid the penalty for man's sin, only through His shed blood and not as a result of good works (Romans 5:1, John 1:12-13, Ephesians 1:7, Ephesians 2:8-9, John 3:16-19).

We believe in the current ministry of the Holy Spirit, which is to convict, indwell, teach, guide, and empower the believer for godly living and service (Acts 1:8, Rom. 8:9-16, 1 Cor. 3:16, Eph. 1:13, Eph. 2:10, Eph. 4:30, John 14:16-18).

We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto resurrection of life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation (Matt. 25:31-46; John 5:25-29; Acts 17:30-31; Ro. 14:10, 12).

We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ (Eph. 2:11-22 and 4:1-6, 11-13, I John 4:11-12, John 17:21-22).
