MMCHE Events and Committee Descriptions

As a co-op all events are planned, prepared, staffed, and cleaned by members. It is required that members serve on a committee each year. Please review the descriptions below before indicating your preferences on the application.

All events described depend on members to lead and complete. Events will not be held without adequate staffing. Due to the nature of some service areas, members filling some needs are selected by the board or an appointed representative of the board and are not listed on the application. Committee chairs secure locations, honor deadlines for applications as applicable, collect registrations and fees when applicable, and delegate tasks to committee participants. Committee chairs are responsible for ensuring any funds collected from event participants are turned into the Treasurer prior to refunding expenses to members. The Treasurer is responsible for reimbursing member expenses.

Committee members are required to faithfully participate in committee meetings called by the committee chair and help plan, organize, and execute the event to which they are assigned. Committee members are required to participate in the event to which they are assigned. Committee member tasks include advertising event(s), setting up the site, cleaning up afterwards, preparing & serving refreshments, uploading photos to be shared with yearbook, and other duties as assigned. Event dates will be added to the calendar as soon as possible. Please be prepared to arrange your schedule so that you may help your committee partners facilitate the event.
