HSN 9Up: How it Works

Chesterfield Presbyterian's Homeschool Network 9Up offers classes for homeschooled students in high school grades. Our goal is to provide the opportunity to take complete courses in select subjects for high school credit, or classes that would contribute to the hours needed for a high school subject, such as grammar for an English class. Class offerings vary from year to year. The instructors set the plans for the year, and the student and parent enact the plans at home.

Students are given assignments to accomplish during the week and are expected to come prepared with all work completed. Classes meet on Tuesdays or Thursdays for lectures, discussions, presentations and lab work. Teachers will provide a syllabus, assignments and semester grade reports, but the parent is ultimately responsible for all record keeping for their students. Parents are also responsible to supervise their student's daily progress during the course of the year, as needed.

The semesters are generally 14 weeks long. Each teacher has the option to add or subtract days at his/her discretion.

There is no study hall provision for students who find themselves with time between classes. Parents will have to make arrangements either to pick up their student or supervise them in the building with permission from the 9Up coordinator.

All information and a registration form can be downloaded from the website. We do not have online registration or online payment at this time. Registrations must be mailed in or dropped off at CPC.

Tuition must be paid in full (ideally) prior to the start of the school year. (See below.) This is due to contractual obligations made with teachers. If necessary, other payment arrangements can be arranged. Classes must reach their minimum sizes in order to be held.

A <u>9Up Parent/Student Orientation</u> will be held the week before classes start on Aug. 14, 2025. Time TBA but it most likely will be 1:00pm. Class schedules and syllabi will be available during Student Orientation.

To register your student(s):

- Mail in the non-refundable **registration fee, the registration form, and one third of the total tuition payment**. Make checks payable to **CPC Homeschool Network** and mail to the address on the registration form.
- **Registration fee prior to June 1st: \$70 per student**, no matter how many classes chosen **Registration fee after June 1st: \$90 per student**
- Pay the second third of the tuition payment by August 1st.
- Pay the last third of the tuition payment by Sept. 1st.
- We will keep you apprised by email regarding the status of the classes you have selected.
