Homeschool Network 9Up offers classes for homeschooled students in the high school grades. Our goal is to provide the opportunity to take complete courses in select subjects for high school credit, or classes that would contribute to the hours needed for a high school subject, such as grammar for an English class. Class offerings vary from year to year. The instructors set the plans for the year, and the student and parent enact the plans at home.

Students are given assignments to accomplish during the week and are expected to come prepared with all work completed. Classes meet on Tuesdays or Thursdays for lectures, discussion, presentations and lab work. Teachers will provide a syllabus, assignments and semester grade reports, but the parent is ultimately responsible for all record keeping for their students. Parents are also responsible to supervise their student's daily progress during the course of the year, as needed.

The semesters are generally 14 weeks long. **Fall Semester classes will run from August 20/22 to November 19/21, 2024, and Winter Semester will run from January 7/9 to April 15/17, 2025**, with spring break on March 20. Each teacher has the option to add or subtract days at his/her discretion.

Tuition must be paid in full (ideally) prior to the start of the school year. This is due to contractual obligations made with teachers. If necessary, other payment arrangements can be considered. **Classes must reach their minimum sizes in order to be held.**

Please note: 9Up Parent/Student Orientation is currently scheduled for **Thursday, August 15, 2024. Time TBA.** Class schedules and syllabi will be available during Student Orientation.

To reserve a space for your student(s):

- Mail in the non-refundable registration fee, the registration form, and half of the total tuition payment by June 1st. Make checks payable to **CPC Homeschool Network** and mail to the address on the registration form.
- Mail in the second half of the tuition payment by August 1st.
- We will keep you apprised by email regarding the status of the classes you have selected.
