Course Description: INTRODUCTION TO TOXICOLOGY 2025

Toxicology is an interesting and very practical science. It is the study of the adverse effects of chemicals on living systems. This short course will introduce students to the basic principles of toxicology and will include many real-life examples of various kinds of chemicals, poisons, venoms and even marketed drugs and how they impact our lives today.

There are no prerequisites for this class. A basic understanding of biology and chemistry would be helpful but is not necessary. The instructor will gear the class and homework toward the level of scientific understanding of the students.

Homework will be minimal. There will be a few quizzes on material covered in class. Students will have the opportunity to research and write a short paper and to present their findings in classs.

There is no required text for the course, but there will be a number of handouts/reading assignments.
