

Course Description: **Government and Economics** Grades 9-12 2023-2024

1st Semester: *Exploring Government* is a high school course that covers the government of the US from its beginning to the present with specific emphasis on the Biblical pattern for government and the US Constitution. Students will learn about federal, state, and local government and become better equipped to understand our country's government as they learn about contemporary issues facing our nation today.

2nd Semester: *Exploring Economics* gives teens the education to understand what's going on in the world around them by emphasizing faith in God and trusting His Word. Students will learn how being knowledgeable about economics will help them to be an informed contributor to the economy on many levels. Students will also study the importance of the free market system as they learn clear explanations of key terms and concepts.
