

Course Description: **Logic** Grades 9-12 2024-2025

Introduction to Logic: Informal Fallacies is a full 1-year high school Logic course that introduces the principle of correct reasoning from a Christian perspective. Students will learn how logic is different from other areas, how God is pro-reason, and how logic intersects with what we know of God through His Word. Topics covered include the basics of inductive and deductive reasoning, syllogisms, if the Christian faith is illogical, and other foundational concepts before examining specific informal logical fallacies.
