

Students will build on basic introductory Spanish proficiency learned in Spanish I. We will focus on four key areas of foreign language learning: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. A strong foundation for Spanish conversation and complex grammar will be introduced. Students will engage in regular Spanish conversational strategies, listen to multimedia videos, read and write about Hispanic culture and geography, and work on advanced vocabulary and grammar memorization. Throughout this course, students should expect to take frequent vocabulary quizzes, a midterm and final exam, 1-2 scheduled phone conversation assessments with the teacher per semester, and regular short conversational presentations. This course will include many fun and engaging games and interactive exercises to tap into multiple learning styles. The main purpose of this course is to help students become more comfortable with intermediate level Spanish conversation and grammar, as well as sharpen their listening and reading comprehension.

Cost of course includes supplies but not texts or workbooks. Texts required:
