



Cell Phone Policy

Although we live in a culture of instant messaging and networking, we would like to encourage parents and students to disconnect from the web when it is not necessary and to engage in building relationships with teachers and other students.

KHS reserves the right to “confiscate” any electronic device, and return such to parents at the end of the “school day,” if a student is using such device inappropriately. Devices such as computers, or tablets should be used **only** for educational purposes during the length of the day. Cell phones **may not** be used to complete math curriculum. Phones may be only used under teacher supervision for educational purposes (e.i. find definition, facts, information, etc.)

The use of cell phones for gaming, social networking (Instagram, facebook, Tik-Tok, Snapchat, etc.), texting friends, posting pictures online during the program hours, etc. Each of these is prohibited during program hours and could result in your child’s phone being taken for the remainder of the school day.

Additionally, we ask that parents use teachers as points of contact throughout the day if they need to get ahold of their child. This is especially important to avoid class disruptions, and to receive updates on early pick up times.

Phones must be put away during the day.
