

HCCE Covid-19 Policy Fall 2021

Guidelines obtained from Snohomish Health District, Washington Department of Health, and CDC as of August 2021. This policy is subject to change at any time.

MASKS

Masks are currently required for people over the age of 5 when indoors while attending HCCE.

Please let us know as soon as possible if anyone in your family is exposed to or is ill with suspected or confirmed Covid-19 so that we can plan for class coverage and if necessary, notify those who may have been exposed at HCCE.

EXPOSURE

If an unvaccinated person in your family has been in close contact (more than 15 minutes) with someone who has Covid-19, we ask that no one in your family attends HCCE until 14 days has passed since exposure.

If a vaccinated person in your family has been in close contact (more than 15 minutes) with someone who has Covid-19, you may still attend but please monitor for Covid-19 symptoms and, if any occur, your family should not attend HCCE until 10 days after symptoms have resolved.

INFECTION

If someone in your immediate family has symptoms of or is diagnosed with Covid-19, you should not attend HCCE until 10 days after symptoms started **and** 24 hours after fever has resolved and symptoms are improving. If additional members of your family become symptomatic, the 10 days restarts from their start of symptoms.
