\* During enrollment, if a class is “full” please join the waitlist. We will evaluate the waitlist to determine the need for additional classes or space.

\* You may enroll in semester specific classes prior to class beginning. If the class does not specify a semester, it is considered a year long class and you will NOT have to re-register in the Spring.
