FISH Homeschool Ministry Academic Excellence Scholarship

FISH would like to recognize Excellent Academic Achievement of homeschooled students. FISH seniors may compete for scholarships . Scholarships will be awarded to the top scholars based on college SAT and/or ACT exam scores.

Requirements:

- Scholar must be a graduating senior and member of FISH since September 1st of their junior year of high school. Once registered with FISH as a junior, that grade level cannot be changed.
- Scholar must score a minimum of 1200 on the SAT (critical reading and math sections) or 26 on the ACT (composite score) to be considered for a scholarship. SAT and ACT scores will be compared using Collegeboard's SAT-ACT Concordance Tables. In the case of a tie, the money will be divided equally among the winners. If three or more scholars tie for first, the sum of the first and second place prizes will be divided equally between them.
- Applications are due by April 15th and must include official SAT or ACT scores along with a completed scholarship application. Keep these dates in mind and take your exams early enough to meet this deadline.
- This application will include a written paragraph about the scholar's goals and future plans.
- Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. No exceptions.
- The paperwork should be mailed to FISH, 11705 Boyette Rd, Suite 254, Riverview, FL 33569 in an envelope clearly marked "FISH Scholarship Application."
- Winners will be notified before the FISH Graduation in May and honored at the graduation ceremony. Recipients must be present to receive the award.
