

## Graduation - SLIDESHOW

**It's time to start putting together the slideshow for graduation day! You will need 5 photos and a head shot for the graduation program.**

A link will be provided to a jotform. Click on it and then start answering the questions and loading your pictures. You must do everything at once, so have it all ready. Below are some more instructions and helpful hints.

**START OUT BY GETTING YOUR 4 PHOTOS IN A FILE ON YOUR DESKTOP LABELED CORRECTLY!**

Photo labeling: Save the photo on your desktop with it's new name. **The name MUST be lastnamefirstname1,etc.** For example, I would have my 4 pictures named JacksonDoreenheadshot, JacksonDoreen1, JacksonDoreen2, JacksonDoreen3. You do the same thing only use your name. There are no spaces or 0 or descriptive phrases. The program alphabetizes everyone so it is important to do the labeling just right.

Headshot is just that - shoulders up recent photo. It is used in the program. Full body is too small. We want your face!

Other pictures: most of the time people use baby, elementary, middle. Large group shots do not work well, this is of your life so the fewer people in the picture the better. You must be in the photo - no photoshopping, special gadgets, etc. The photos must be real - no magazines, etc. **NO NAKED** pictures, even of a baby. Everyone must have on a shirt and be modestly covered; no bikinis, etc.

The questions are easy!

1. Full name - first name, last name. You can include your middle name. Put your name like you want it to be in the program and on your certificate.
2. Email - the email address of the person I can contact if I have a question.
3. # years homeschooled - this is a whole number between 1 and 13.
4. Life verse - If you don't have one, ask your mom. Copy and paste or type out the verse from Bible Gateway or your Bible.
5. Reference - The Book and chapter and verse.
7. Version - which Bible version did your verse come from? ex: NKJV, NIV, CSB, etc
8. Future plans - a quick glimpse of what are planning to do next. This is written in first person (I am..) You can put what college you are going to, what you are planning to study, what work you are doing, etc. If you don't know you can put "I am waiting on the Lord's direction", "I am considering my options in life." or anything similiar.
8. Fun Fact - what do we want to know. You can put an achievement, a hobby, or something that is unique to you. EX: "I love all things pink", "I have worked 2000 service hours" "I jump out of airplanes" "I completed my Eagle Award", etc. Make sure it is true, it is about you, and it doesn't involve comparing yourself to others.
9. Now load those pictures that you correctly labeled and are saved in a folder for easy access! After you load your information, both have to be triple check. Then a mock up is done and triple checked. Finally a finished print and slideshow can be made. The headshot is only in the program along with the information. The other 3 pictures go in the slideshow.
