- **Presence.** Attendance and active participation of adults and children are encouraged regularly at Heritage meetings to help build community.
- **Punctuality.** In order to respect the time of each group coordinator and for your family to get the most benefit of the activities planned, members are expected to be ready to begin the activity at the specified time.
- **Preparedness.** We work with our own children and with others’ children when we meet together. Protection of the group activity from any “outside” activity is expected. Working with your children at home to help them succeed when they come to the group is also expected. Tasks are shared and everyone is expected to pitch in to make the activities meaningful for all.
- **Politeness.** Every parent and child is expected to treat each other and any others the group comes in contact with courteously. Should an issue arise, the Matthew 18:15-17 principles apply. Modesty in dress is expected from adults and children.

Membership Guidelines

Prospective Members: Membership is open to Christ-loving homeschooling families where at least one child is PreK 4 or older.

Heritage seeks God’s wisdom and guidance in every area. Should the Lord bless the group with growth, all glory goes to God.

Admittance of new families is at the discretion of the Board of Directors, which takes into account a variety of factors.

Visitors: Heritage’s activities are open to its members. Much preparation and coordination goes into planning each meeting or event.
