

Evaluation

Florida law requires that all independent homeschoolers submit an annual evaluation for each child to the superintendent on or before the anniversary date of establishing your home education program.

Your portfolio needs to be evaluated by a Florida certified teacher. This can be a friend or family member. For your benefit we also have a list of evaluators on our website. Please contact any of them for more information, including their service fees.

Parents also have the option to have their child tested, but the results of the test do NOT need to be sent in to the school district. It can be kept in the student's portfolio as a reference.
