

## **Payback Funds from the Lafayette Speech & Debate Tournaments**

- Profit generated by the Lafayette Speech & Speech Tourney may be distributed to the Quo Vadis Speech & Debate Club families who successfully completed the previous season in the Quo Vadis Speech & Debate Club **and** who are current members in the club. Successfully completing a season in Quo Vadis means that the family actively attended the club meetings the previous fall and competed in the required Lafayette Speech and Debate Tourney.
- These funds can only be used by qualified families for registration fees for speech and debate competitions **other** than the Lafayette tourney and/or for NCFCA affiliation fees.
- Funds will be used in a first come, first served basis and are available to qualified families for the above listed expenses until the fund is depleted. For the 2010-2011 season, we have \$1500 available.
- Families must request these funds in writing by filling out the form posted on the Quo Vadis webpage. This form is automatically sent to the Quo Vadis treasurer and the Quo Vadis head coach. After their approval, a check will be issued.
- These funds will be available the following club season. For example, the profit from the 2010 tournament can be requested for competitions in Fall 2010- Summer 2011.
- All payback funds not used in a given season will be transferred back to the general club fund.
