

CFS Events Charter

Purpose

The primary function of the Events Ambassadors is to provide oversight and guidance to the committees that coordinate and facilitate group activities that enhance the social aspect of a Christian homeschool education.

Membership

The CFS Board will appoint a current CFS Board member couple to serve as Events Ambassadors each academic year (July through June). A husband and wife serving as Ambassadors will count as one member and allowed one vote (related to Board business).

If feasible, the various committee chairs shall be elected by a majority vote of each committee. Otherwise, CFS Board Event Ambassador approval is adequate.

The area of Events is populated by: Events Ambassadors, Graduation Committee Chair, Spring Field Day Coordinator, Winter Family Dance Coordinator, Fall Picnic Chair, Spring Formal Committee Chair, and other event areas as needed.

The Graduation Committee will be populated by senior parents and graduates. Spring Field Day, Winter Family Dance, Fall Picnic Chair, Spring Formal, and other event committees (as needed) will be populated by the current academic year volunteer form.

Length of Term

All members of the committees serve at least one-year terms.

Meeting Schedule

The committee's will meet on an as-needed basis.

Roles and Responsibilities

The Events Ambassadors are responsible for:

- Providing support, guidance, and oversight to CFS sponsored group social events
- Maintain policies relating to social activities sponsored by CFS
- Maintain policies relating to the CFS Events Committee functions and charter
- Reviewing the charter and suggest revisions, as needed, on an annual basis
- Reporting activities and recommendations for action to the Board at each CFS Board meeting.
