CCHSA's annual Kickoff is coming up soon! As we have for many years, we'll again be hosting a used curriculum and book sale at this event.

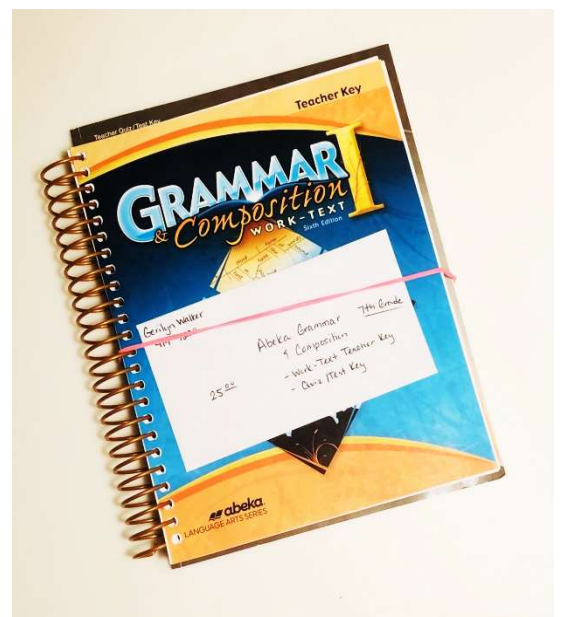
If you plan to come to Kickoff to either sell your old books or buy new (to you!) books, please be sure to read through the information below completely, especially if you're new to our book sale. We organize our book sale in such a way that sellers do not have to stay with their books and are free to enjoy the event. Reminder: Kickoff will be 1 p.m. – 5 p.m., Saturday, June 19, at Granberry Conference Center on the Louisiana College campus.

SELLERS: If you wish to put items in the book sale, you may begin bringing your materials to sell starting at 11 a.m. Please try to have everything there no later than 12:45, as the crowd will start arriving and begin shopping around 1:00. We will be organizing all books by grade level, so it will be helpful and save time setting up if you have them sorted by grade level when you arrive. If some of your materials cover multiple grade levels, don't worry! We will have some overlapping areas so that is fine.

Any curriculum, learning manipulatives or supplies, and family-friendly fiction or nonfiction books are acceptable. Please make sure your items have something to do with homeschool/learning, or are good fiction/nonfiction books for building a home library. Christian/inspirational books such as Bible study or devotional books are also acceptable.

On every item you wish to sell, please attach to front or tuck in the front cover an envelope with the grade level/s, your name, phone number, and price of item. If you are selling a set, please make sure they are rubber-banded or bagged together to avoid confusion.



You are also welcome to bring a box of “one price” books. Attach a large envelope to the box with the price of the books clearly marked. Boxes cannot be placed on the table and must stay under tables to keep pathways clear, though we will make sure they are visible and accessible to the shoppers.

We will also have a "Free" table set up for donations, so if you have items you would like to give away rather than sell, please place on this table.

You are not required to stay at Kickoff the entire time.

Money will be taken up by our staff from the collection boxes toward the end of the event and you will receive all your envelopes for sold items when you come to pick-up your unsold items. Please plan to pick up your money and unsold items by 5 p.m. when Kickoff ends.

PLEASE: Do not leave your unsold books! Please remove all unsold items promptly as we do not have the manpower to remove them for you. Any books left will be donated to charity. Tip: If you are bringing a lot of material to sell, we have discovered from experience that it is wise to make a list of everything you have so that when you come to pick up unsold items you can check off what has sold and know exactly what is left to pick up.



BUYERS: This will be a cash only sale. When you have found an item you would like to purchase, remove the envelope, enclose your payment, and then drop the envelope in one of the marked boxes located on the tables. Please try to bring small bills, as many of the books are only a few dollars and there will be no one available to make change for you. In the past, we’ve found that a good supply of \$1 and \$5 bills and maybe some pocket change is wise! If you’re shopping from one of the “one-price” boxes, there will be an envelope attached to the boxes where you will need to drop your payment.

We use this system for our book sale so that everyone is free to enjoy the event and workshops without having to “man” the book sale tables the entire time.

If you plan to invite friends interested in homeschooling to Kickoff, please remember to pass along this buyer info so that they will be prepared if they want to purchase anything.
